2008 WELDING INTERNSHIP

Each year Al-Jon Manufacturing, L.L.C. brings welding students to Ottumwa, IA.

Interns will learn more about the relationship between academia / theory and the technical / practical world. Interns will work in a weld shop in a manufacturing environment, 40 hours a week, for 6 weeks. Interns will experience a "real world" setting by: interacting through-out the organization, involvement in Lean Manufacturing Principals, participating in departmental meetings, shadowing a senior welder, exposure to advance manufacturing initiatives and completing specific projects.

In addition to this being a paid Internship - four (4) college credits are available to students who satisfactory complete the 240-hour program.

Example of program content:

Half day in the functional areas of HR, Safety, QA and Lean Manufacturing.

Full day with Welding Drafter, Welding Supervisor and Welding Superintendent.

Up to one week as a participant in a Kaizen event.

Four (4)+ weeks shadowing a senior welder/trainer.
